Smoke Alarms and Fire Sprinklers

Albany Fire Chief Marc McGinn joins us to speak about smoke alarm technology – the good, the bad, and the ineffective – and fire sprinklers.

He will share the results of independent research on smoke alarms that upsets many notions of what is an acceptable and effective system.

Mr. McGinn will be accompanied by his battalion chief, Brian Crudo, who will discuss California's new fire sprinkler code going into effect on January 1, 2011.
